Lv 5.11Never put incense on wrongdoers' grain offerings. Lv 3.11Never eat the head priest's grain offering. Lv 6.16Never bake a grain offering with leavening. Lv 6.10Priests: Eat what's left of grain offerings. Lv 6.9Bring all offerings to temple at the next festival. Dt 12.5-6Never hold back any payment you've sworn to pay. Dt 23.22Offer all sacrifices in temple. Dt 12.11Bring all sacrifices from outside Israel to temple. Dt 12.26Never slaughter sacrifices outside the temple courtyard. Lv 17.4Never offer any sacrifices outside the temple courtyard. Dt 12.13Offer two lambs every day. Nu 28.3Light a fire on the altar every day. Lv 6.6Never put out the altar's fire. Lv 6.6Remove the ashes from the altar every day. Lv 6.3Burn incense every day. Ex 30.7Light the menorah every day. Ex 27.21Head priest: Bring a grain offering every day. Lv 6.1320 additional lambs on Sabbath. Nu 28.9Make showbread. Ex 25.30Additional offerings every new month. Nu 28.11Additional offerings on Passover. Nu 28.19Offer a wave offering from the flour of new wheat. Lv 23.10Count off seven weeks after the wave offering. Lv 23.15Additional offerings on Pentecost. Nu 28.26Bring two loaves with the additional Pentecost offering. Lv 23.17Additional offerings on Rosh Hashanah. Nu 29.24Additional offerings on Yom Kippur. Nu 29.8Additional offerings on Sukkot. Nu 29.13Additional offerings on the last day of Sukkot. Nu 29.35Never eat unfit or blemished sacrifices. Dt 14.3Never eat sacrifices offered with bad intentions. Lv 7.18Never eat sacrifices left uneaten too long. Lv 22.30Never eat leftovers from sacrifices. Lv 19.8Never eat sacrifices which became impure. Lv 7.19Impure people can't eat from sacrifices. Lv 7.20Burn leftovers from sacrifices. Lv 7.17Burn impure sacrifices. Lv 7.19Follow procedure for Yom Kippur. Lv 16.3If you profane holy objects, pay for them plus 20 percent; plus a sacrifice. Lv 5.16Never use holy animals for work. Dt 15.19Never shear holy lambs as the proper time. Ex 12.6Never slaughter Passover lambs while you still possess leaven. Ex 23.18Never leave Passover lambs' fat overnight. Ex 23.18Follow procedure for the second Passover lamb. Nu 9.11Eat Passover lambs with matzah and major, on the night of 14 Nissan. Ex 12.8Eat the second Passover lamb on the night of 15 Iyyar. Nu 9.11Never eat Passover lambs raw or boiled. Ex 12.9Never take Passover lamb meat outside your gro up. Ex 12.46Apostates can't eat the Passover lamb meat. Ex 12.43Employees, slave or free, can't eat the Passover lamb meat. Ex 12.45Uncircumcised males can't eat the Passover lamb meat. Ex 12.48Never break any of the Passover lambs' bones. Ex 12.46Nor break the bones of the second Passover offering. Nu 9.12Never leave any Passover lamb meat overnight. Lv 10.12Nor from the second Passover lamb. Nu 9.12Never leave any Passover lamb meat from the holiday offering past the 16th. Dt 16.4Be at temple on Passover, Pentecost, and Sukkot. Dt 16.16Celebrate with peace offerings for Passover, Pentecost, and Sukkot. Ex 23.14Rejoice with peace offerings for Passover, Pentecost, and Sukkot. Dt 16.14Never appear at temple without an offering. Dt 16.16Never keep from rejoicing with, and giving gifts to, Levites. Dt 12.19Gather everyone on the Sukkot after the seventh year. Dt 31.12Set firstborn animals aside. Ex 13.12Priests can't eat unblemished firstborn animals outside Jerusalem. Dt 12.17Never buy back firstborn animals. Nu 18.17Animals are to be tithed. Lv 27.32Never buy back tithes of animals. Lv 27.33Everyone must offer a sin offering, in temple, for sins. Lv 4.27Bring an offering to temple if you're not sure of guilt. Lv 5.17-18Bring an offering to temple if guilt has been established. Lv 5.25Bring differing offerings to temple depending on the person's wealth. Lv 5.7-11The nation must bring an offering to temple when the whole nation sins. Lv 4.13Women, after vaginal discharge, must bring an offering to temple after baptism. Lv 15.28-29Women, after giving birth, must bring an offering to temple after baptism. Lv 12.6Men, after ejaculating, must bring an offering to temple after baptism. Lv 19.13Never covet, nor plot to get someone else's stuff. Ex 20.14Never want other people's stuff. Dt 5.18Give back stolen objects, or equivalent money. Lv 5.23Never ignore lost items. Dt 22.3Return lost items. Dt 22.1Assess damages done by assault. Ex 21.18Never murder. Ex 20.12The penalty of murder shouldn't be a fine. Nu35.31Accidental killers must be sent to refuge cities. Nu 35.25Never pay your way out of being sent to a refuge city. Nu 35.32Murderers can't be killed before a standing trial.
