Security 1

- Naomi had no means or hope
- Naomi cared for Ruth
- Parent wishing for a child better life!
- Best of intent how is as important as what

2 Now is not Boaz our kinsman, with whose maids you were? Behold, he winnows barley at the threshing floor tonight.



3 Wash yourself therefore, and anoint yourself and put on your best clothes, and go down to the threshing floor; but do not make yourself known to the man until he has finished eating and drinking.



4 It shall be when he lies down, that you shall notice the place where he lies, and you shall go and uncover his feet and lie down; then he will tell you what you shall do."

Seeking 2-5

- Naomi has a plan based on human wisdom
- Boaz our 'kinsman' NOT goel יָדַע relative
- Process of reaping threshing winnowing
- Piles of unguarded grain Boaz will stay himself



Seeking 2-5

- Wash yourself anoint yourself
- Dress up go to threshing floor
- Lie down at his feet –
- He will tell you what to do next...

- Obedient to desperate
- Rahab lied to save 12 spies of Israel
- Hagar yielded to Abram for a child of Promise
- Joshua trusted the Gibeonites without prayer



Secretly 6

- Rahab lied to save 12 spies of Israel
 - She might have missed...
 - 'we are not careful...'
 - 'passed through their midst unaware...'
- Hagar yielded to Abram for a child of Promise
 - Ishmael Nebaioth Nabataeans AMEN
- Joshua trusted the Gibeonites without prayer

8 It happened in the middle of the night that the man was startled and bent forward; and behold, a woman was lying at his feet.



9 He said, "Who are you?" And she answered, "I am Ruth your maid. So spread your covering over your maid, for you are a <u>close relative</u>."



10 Then he said, "May you be blessed of the LORD, my daughter. You have shown your last kindness to be better than the first by not going after young men, whether poor or rich.



11 Now, my daughter, do not fear. I will do for you whatever you ask, for all my people in the city know that you are a woman of excellence.

- 'spread your covering' presenting herself for a wife
