





### Passover 23:4-5 Pesach



- 14th of Nisan March/April
- Israel deliverance from Egypt Exodus 12
- Believer deliverance from Sin
- Christ Crucified John 19
- "For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed."
- Remembers the blood of the lamb
- Reminders of the Blood of The Lamb






### **Unleavened Bread 23:6-8**

- 15th of Nisan
- Leaven often symbolizes SIN
- Bread without Leaven Matzo
- Jesus without Sin
- Bread of Life born in Bethlehem (John 6:35)
- Master of Bread feeding 5000



Lev 23:10 "Speak to the sons of Israel and say to them, 'When you enter the land which I am going to give to you and reap its harvest, then you shall bring in the sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest.





## Firstfruits 23:9-14

- 16<sup>th</sup> Nisan Sunday
- First day of the week bring offering
- "But now Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep."
- We celebrate Firstfruit of Resurrection
- We bring an offering to the Lord



#### Feast of Weeks 23:15-22

שָׁבֻעָת

- 6<sup>th</sup> Sivan May/June
- 50 days = Pentecost day after 7 Sabbaths
- 1 of 3 Pilgrimage Feasts Passover/Atonement
- Jesus raised taught 40 days ascended
- Jerusalem filled for Shavout (weeks)
- Acts 2 Pentecost!

23,24 Again the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'In the seventh month on the first of the month you shall have a rest, a reminder by blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.





# Feast of Trumpets 23:23-25

רֹאִשׁ הַשְּׁנְה

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tishri September/October
- Trumpet marked end of day
- Trumpet marked gathering
- "For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed."
- Shofar Rams horn or Ibex (mine)
- Announcement of great significance Atonement!

Lev 23:26,27 The LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "On exactly the tenth day of this seventh month is the day of atonement; it shall be a holy convocation for you, and you shall humble your souls and present an offering by fire to the LORD.





# Day of Atonement Lev 23:26-32



- 10<sup>th</sup> Tishri (Yom Kippur)
- Most solemn holy day
- Kippur covering blood on Mercy Seat
- Leviticus 16 2 Goats offered & borne away!
- Jesus is Lamb offered Goat Sacrifice Goat Departed
- Book of Jonah is read 'as Jonah was...'

Lev 23:33,34 Again the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'On the fifteenth of this seventh month is the Feast of Booths for seven days to the LORD.

40 Now on the first day you shall take for yourselves the foliage of beautiful trees, palm branches and boughs of leafy trees and willows of the brook, and you shall rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days.

42,43 You shall live in booths for seven days; all the native-born in Israel shall live in booths, so that your generations may know that I had the sons of Israel live in booths when I brought them out from the land of Egypt. I am the LORD your God."

# Feast of Booths Lev 23:33-43



- 15-21 Tishri (Tabernacles Sukkot)
- God delivered from Egypt Tabernacle
- Jewish celebration Water from Siloam
- "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink." John 7
- Jewish celebration Torches at the Temple
- "I am the light of the world." John 8
- Emmanuel God with us!
