



Threat of Sin to Fellowship

1 John 1:5-10



"The essence of sin is we human beings substituting ourselves for God, while the essence of salvation is God substituting himself for us. We put ourselves where only God deserves to be; God puts himself where we deserve to be." John Stott



1 John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.



God is Light! 5

This is (still) the 'message' – Light of the World
After 60 years – any second thoughts?
Light – no darkness AT ALL!



"Faith is NOT a leap into the dark but a step toward the Light!"



1 John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth;



Darkness 6

Darkness – anything without light
Fellowship is with Him
Fellowship lights our path
Fellowship practices the 'truth'
Fellowship is us together with all the above!



Virtue - even attempted virtue – brings light; indulgence brings fog. - C.S. Lewis



1 John 1:7 but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.



Light 7

Walking in the Light – WWJD? Footwashing!
We have fellowship around Jesus – not ourselves
The blood cleanses the lens of His life in us
Sin covers the light given from Christ by faith
Sin comes between and blocks His light

Chiasm of 1 John 1:8-10

Verse 9 – confession & cleanses

Verse 8 – no 'sin' - nature

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Verse 10 – not 'sinned' - personal



1 John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us.



Sin 8

- If we say 'no sin'
- •I have not been born in sin Federal / Seminal
- •I was born innocent –
- •I am ok unless...
- •I can fix this...

1 John 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar and His word is not in us.



Sinned 10

I have 'not sinned' – 'that doesn't count'
Who do we get to interview?
Pagans don't often claim sinless lives
Self-righteous attempt self-authentication
Not His Word! – He is a liar?

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.



Cleansed 9

Key verb – 'He is faithful and just'
He will forgive – bear away
He will cleanse – make whole and right
Proof: If we confess – He will do all these
'confess' – agree with God – not Him to us



"This day, my God, I hate sin not because it damns me, but because it has done You wrong. To have grieved my God is the worst grief to me." Charles H. Spurgeon

Threat of Sin to Fellowship

• We underestimate the devastation of sin in our life • We deceive ourselves with source or frequency • We under value the support of FELLOWSHIP! • We do not truly 'confess' = agree with God • HATE PRODUCES GUILT - SHORT TERM • LOVE GIVES MOTIVE TO OBEY - LIFETIME
