# *Walk* WITH *Me*

1 John 5:5 Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

# *Walk* WITH *Me*

6 This is the One who came by water and blood, Jesus Christ; not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood. It is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.

# Walk WITH Me

## Who is He? 5,6

- ‘water’ and ‘blood’
- Spirit testifies!
- 4 choices – Ordinances, Cross, Tabernacle – Life
  - *Baptism to the Cross by the Spirit!*
- Overcomer by what He has done – not me!
- He is the Son of God – prophecy – history – truth!

9 If we receive the testimony of men, the testimony of God is greater; for the testimony of God is this, that He has testified concerning His Son.

- God as witness
  - Ministry (dove & voice)
  - Word – given by men to men
  - Extra verses

# Walk WITH Me

7 For there are three that bear witness in heaven: the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one.

8 And there are three that bear witness on earth: the Spirit, the water, and the blood; and these three agree as one. NKJV

## Who says He is? 7-9

- God as witness
  - Ministry (dove & voice)
  - Word – given by men to men
  - Extra verses
- Men as witnesses
  - Law – Medicine – Buildings – Commerce

# *Walk* WITH *Me*

Scribes were trustworthy – not perfect!

Many copies – sources – Luke

.02 – 1/5 of 1% variants in 5800 Greek texts

No dictionary! No spellcheck!

No doctrine – most are obvious! ‘onion’?

# *Walk* WITH *Me*

10 The one who believes in the Son of God has the testimony in himself; the one who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has given concerning His Son.
