Matthew 1:22,23


Today's selection is possibly the oldest Christmas carol that is still in use. It is a Victorian translation (John Neale, 1851) of a 12th-century Latin carol, which was in turn adapted from a set of 8th century monastic antiphons (sung back and forth)

This hymn reflects the tension between already and not yet. It anticipates both the birth and return of Christ. It is at once the song of Israel awaiting her Messiah, and that of the Church awaiting His return.
