

HONOR YOUR FATHER'S

Ephesians NKJV 6: Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ² “Honor your father and mother,” which is the first commandment with promise: ³ “that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.”

Hebrews NKJV 9: ¹⁴ how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without ^[a]spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

1. PROTECTOR

1 Timothy NKJV 3: ⁴ one who rules his own house well, having *his* children in submission with all reverence ⁵ (for if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the church of God?);

2. PROVIDER

1 Timothy NKJV 5: ⁸ But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

2 Corinthians 9: ⁶ But this / say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows ^[a]bountifully will also reap ^[e]bountifully. ⁷ So *let* each one *give* as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of ^[n]necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. ⁸ And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may have an abundance for every good work.

3. PROMOTER

Ephesians 4: ²⁹ Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary ^[n]edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

Colossians NKJV 3: ²¹ Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.

4. PRIEST

Ephesians NKJV 6: ⁴ And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

Ephesians NKJV 6: ¹⁸ praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—
