

THE TRILOGY OF THE RESURRECTION

Matthew NKJV 20: ¹⁷ Now Jesus, going up to Jerusalem, took the twelve disciples aside on the road and said to them, ¹⁸ “Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribes; and they will condemn Him to death, ¹⁹ and deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock and to scourge and to crucify. And the third day He will rise again.”

1 John 4: ⁸ He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

1. THE DEATH

John NKJV 19: So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged *Him*. ² And the soldiers twisted a crown of thorns and put *it* on His head, and they put on Him a purple robe. ³ Then they said,^[a] “Hail, King of the Jews!” And they struck Him with their hands.

²⁸ After this, Jesus, knowing^[e] that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, “I thirst!” ²⁹ Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put *it* on hyssop, and put *it* to His mouth. ³⁰ So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, “It is finished!” And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit

1 John AMP 3: ¹⁶ By this we know [and have come to understand the depth and essence of His precious] love: that He [willingly] laid down His life for us [because He loved us].

2 Corinthians 5: ²¹ For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

2. PAID THE PRICE

Matthew AMP 12: ⁴⁰ for just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the sea monster, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Acts AMP 2: ³¹ he foresaw and spoke [prophetically] of the resurrection of the Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed), that He was not abandoned [in death] to

Hades (the realm of the dead), nor did His body undergo decay. ³² God raised this Jesus [bodily from the dead], and of that [fact] we are all witnesses.

3. THE RESURRECTION

Luke 9: ²¹ And He strictly warned and commanded them to tell this to no one, ²² saying, “The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day.”

Colossians AMP 2: ¹⁴ having canceled out the [g]certificate of debt consisting of [h]legal demands [which were in force] against us and which were hostile to us. ¹⁵ When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities [those supernatural forces of evil operating against us], He made a public example of them [exhibiting them as captives in His triumphal procession], having triumphed over them through [i]the cross.
