

# Praise and Worship Sets the Environment

Revelations NKJV 5:12 “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain  
To receive power and riches and wisdom,  
And strength and honor and glory and blessing!”

## 1. We can set the environment to praise Him

**Acts NKJV 16:** <sup>25</sup> But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. <sup>26</sup> Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone’s chains were loosed.

**Psalms NKJV 3:** <sup>3</sup> But You, O Lord, *are* a shield *for* me,  
My glory and the One who lifts up my head.

**Hebrews NKJV 13:** <sup>15</sup> Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of *our* lips, *giving* thanks to His name.

## 2. When we praise Him we are practicing being in His presence

**Hebrews NKJV 4:** <sup>13</sup> And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things *are* naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we *must give* account.

**Hebrews NKJV 12:** <sup>6</sup> For whom the Lord loves He chastens,  
And scourges every son whom He receives.”

**Psalms NKJV 16:** <sup>11</sup> In Your presence *is* fullness of joy;  
At Your right hand *are* pleasures forevermore.
