Psalms NKJV 106:1 Praise [a] the Lord! Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for *He is* good! For His mercy *endures* forever.

Psalms NKJV 113:1 Praise at the Lord! Praise, O servants of the Lord, Praise the name of the Lord!

Psalms KJV 117:1 O praise the Lord, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people.

Psalms NKJV 150:6 Let everything that has breath praise the Lord.

1. Principles of Praise

Principles:

- To praise means to commend, to approve, to give a favorable judgment, to glorify, and to esteem.
- 2. Praise is expressing approval and esteeming Him

Psalms NKJV 59: ¹⁶ But I will sing of Your power; Yes, I will sing aloud of Your mercy in the morning; For You have been my defense And refuge in the day of my trouble.

¹⁷ To You, O my Strength, I will sing praises; For God *is* my defense, My God of mercy.
