The Progression of Your Praise

Psalms KJV 223 But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel.

Psalms NKJV 100: ⁴ Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise.

Hebrews NKJV 13: ⁵ Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

1. Todah (Towdah)

Todah Hebrew word that means giving thanks, it is used in songs of worship and is translated as "Praise", "Thanksgiving", and "Giving Thanks"

Psalms NKJV 26:7 That I may proclaim with the voice of thanksgiving, And tell of all Your wondrous works.

Psalms NKJV 107:22 Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, And declare His works with prejoicing

2. Yodah

Yodah is to extend hands to the Lord in reverence and worship, you begin to take control over your body and your mind.

Psalms NKJV 134:2 Lift up your hands *in* the sanctuary, And bless the Lord.

1 Timothy 2:88 I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting;

3. Halal

Halal means: to be clear, to shine, to make a show, boast, celebrate, commend, insane,

Psalms NKJV 34:2 My soul shall make its boast in the Lord; The humble shall hear *of it* and be glad.

Luke NKJV 17: ¹¹ Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. ¹² Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. ¹³ And they lifted up *their* voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

- ¹⁴ So when He saw *them,* He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.
- ¹⁵ And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God,
