

PROMISE

Promise: **1.** In a general sense, a declaration, written or verbal, made by one person to another, which binds the person who makes it,

2 Peter AMP 1: ⁴For by these He has bestowed on us His precious and magnificent promises [of inexpressible value], so that by them you may escape from the immoral freedom that is in the world because of disreputable desire, and become sharers of the divine nature.

1. P-Privileges

1 Peter NKJV 2: ⁹But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

2. R-Response

Ephesians NKJV 6: ¹⁰Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ¹¹Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the [b]wiles of the devil. ¹²For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of [c]the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*. ¹³Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Mark NKJV 11: ²²So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God. ²³For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

3. O-Obedience

Isaiah NKJV 1: ¹⁹If you are willing and obedient, You shall eat the good of the land;

²⁰But if you refuse and rebel, You shall be devoured by the sword”;
For the mouth of the Lord has spoken.

4. M-Mighty

2 Corinthians NKJV 10: ⁴ For the weapons of our warfare *are* not [a]carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, ⁵ casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

5. I-Integrity

2 Peter AMP 3: ⁹ The Lord does not delay [as though He were unable to act] *and* is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is [extraordinarily] patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

6. S-Sure

2 Corinthians 1: ²⁰ For all the promises of God in Him *are* Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

Hebrews 13: ⁸ Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever.

7. E-Endure

2 Timothy NKJV 2: ³ You therefore must endure[a] hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

2 Timothy 3: ¹² Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.
