

## LIFE STYLES THAT COMMUNICATE WITH GOD

John NKJV 10: <sup>27</sup>My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.

### 1. God loves you and wants to help with your life,

1 Corinthians 2: <sup>9</sup>But as it is written:

“Eye has not seen, nor ear heard,

Nor have entered into the heart of man

The things which God has prepared **for those who love Him.**”<sup>10</sup> But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.

John NKJV 10: <sup>10</sup>The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

**(IN ABUNDANCE, TO THE FULL, UNTIL IT OVERFLOWS!)**

John NKJV 16: <sup>23</sup>“And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. <sup>24</sup>Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, **that your joy may be full.**”

1 Peter NKJV 5: <sup>7</sup>casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

**Philippians 4:** <sup>6</sup>Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; <sup>7</sup>and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Matthew NKJV 11: <sup>28</sup>Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup>Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am <sup>10</sup>gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup>For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light.”

### 2. Being in faith places you in the best position to fellowship with God

Hebrews NKJV 11: <sup>6</sup>But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him

- No word of God then no faith, you can't have one without the other,

Romans NKJV 10: <sup>17</sup> So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God

John NKJV 14: <sup>23</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will **keep My word**; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make **Our home with him**.

- **Being in faith is the way he communicates to you and causes you to win**

### **3. You must keep your faith active in your life**

Romans NKJV 10: <sup>17</sup> So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God

### **4. Why does it seem so hard to stay in faith?**

Hebrews AMP 11:1 Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, <sup>the title deed</sup>) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see *and* the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

- **Because are in the flesh we want to the report of the senses**

2 Corinthians NKJV 4: <sup>18</sup> while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen *are* temporary, but the things which are not seen *are* eternal.

- **Will you believe the report of God’s word over your senses?**

2 Peter 2: <sup>24</sup> who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose <sup>stripes</sup> you were healed. <sup>2</sup>

Romans NKJV 4: calls those things which do not exist as though they did;
