## The lifestyle of Worship

Luke NASB 4:8 Jesus replied to him, "It is written: 'You shall worship the Lord your God and serve Him only."

**Exodus CEV 20:** <sup>4</sup> Do not make idols that look like anything in the sky or on earth or in the ocean under the earth. <sup>5</sup> Don't bow down and worship idols. I am the Lord your God, and I demand all your love.

Matthew NIV 22: <sup>37</sup> Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment.

Romans NASB 12: Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

Romans NASB 14: 18 For the one who serves Christ in this way is acceptable to God and approved by other people.

**Philippians NKJV 2:** <sup>3</sup> *Let* nothing *be done* through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

2. How is your leading someone to Christ an act of worship?

Romans NKJV 15: 16 that I might be a minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

Romans NKJV 10: <sup>14</sup> How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? <sup>15</sup> And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!"

3. How generous are you with your resources, time, natural gifts, spiritual, finances?

Philippians NKJV 4: <sup>18</sup> Indeed I whave all and abound. I am full, having received from Epaphroditus the things *sent* from you, a sweet-smelling aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God. <sup>19</sup> And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

John NKJV 3: 16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son,

**Ephesians NKJV 5:** <sup>8</sup> For you were once darkness, but now *you are* light in the Lord. Walk as children of light <sup>9</sup> (for the fruit of the □Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), <sup>10</sup> finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. <sup>11</sup> And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather □expose *them*.
