

# RIGTHEOUS AND HOLINESS

Recap:

Roman NKJV 8: <sup>5</sup> For those live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those *who live* according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. <sup>6</sup> For to be **☐**carnally minded *is* death, but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace. <sup>7</sup> Because the **☐**carnal mind *is* enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. <sup>8</sup> So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

## 1. Righteousness and Holiness

Ephesians NKJV 4: <sup>20</sup> But you have not so learned Christ, <sup>21</sup> if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: <sup>22</sup> that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, <sup>23</sup> and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, <sup>24</sup> and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

John NKJV 4: <sup>24</sup> God *is* Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”

## 2. Jesus has become our righteousness.

1. **Corinthians NKJV 1: <sup>30</sup>** But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption

## 3. God can only accept us based on who we are in our born-again spirits!

Isaiah NKJV 64: <sup>6</sup> But we are all like an unclean *thing*,  
And all our righteousnesses *are* like **☐**filthy rags;

Romans NKJV 3: <sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, <sup>24</sup> being justified **☐**freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
