THE MANY RIVERS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

John NKJV 7: ³⁷ On the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. ³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." ³⁹ But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those weblieving in Him would receive; for the wHoly Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

1. The Rivers of Worship and Praise

Acts NKJV 2: ⁸ And how *is it that* we hear, each in our own elanguage in which we were born? ⁹ Parthians and Medes and Elamites, those dwelling in Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰ Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya adjoining Cyrene, visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, ¹¹ Cretans and eArabs—we hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God."

• The Holy Spirit can take your worship to another level in God,

Act NKJV 10: ⁴⁶ For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God. Then Peter answered, ⁴⁷ "Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we *have?*"

2. The Rivers of Witness

John NKJV 15: ²⁶ "But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me. ²⁷ And you also will bear witness, because you have been with Me from the beginning.

John NKJV 16: 14 He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you.15 All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare *it* to you

Mark NKJV 16: ¹⁷ And these signs will follow those who abelieve: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸ they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."
