

The Progression of Your Praise 2

Psalms NKJV 150: ⁶ Let everything that has breath praise the Lord.

1 Thessalonians NKJV 5: ¹⁸ in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

Psalms NKJV 34: My soul shall make its boast in the Lord;
The humble shall hear *of it* and be glad.

4. Shabach

Defined: address with a loud voice, in a sense of triumph, glory and glory,

Philippians NKJV 4: Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷ and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

5. Zamar

To touch the strings or parts of a musical instrument, Zamar has the connotation of celebration with song and music, and it is the fifth element of the progression of praise.

Psalms NKJV 105: ² Sing to Him, sing psalms to Him; Talk of all His wondrous works!

Psalms NKJV 150: ⁶ Let everything that has breath praise the Lord.

6. Barack

To knell, carries the sense of hushed expectancy, this is when God responds to your praise and the Holy Spirit begins to minister filling the praise that was offered.

Psalms NKJV 95: ⁶ Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the Lord our Maker.

Acts NKJV 2: When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all ¹ with one accord in one place. ² And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ Then there appeared to them ⁴ divided tongues, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of

them. ⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

7. Tehillah

That place of worship where the Holy Spirit enters the worship and begins to sing through you, these are unpremeditated utterances inspired by the Holy Spirit,

Psalms NKJV 40: ³ He has put a new song in my mouth—
Praise to our God;
Many will see *it* and fear,
And will trust in the Lord.

Isaiah NKJV 42: ⁸ I *am* the Lord, that *is* My name;
And My glory I will not give to another,
Nor My praise to carved images.

1 Corinthians NKJV 14: ¹⁴ For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful. ¹⁵ What is *the conclusion* then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will also pray with the understanding. I will sing with the spirit, and I will also sing with the understanding.
