Questions to reflect on from the message:

- Why does Mark end his Gospel the way he does?
- What are some reasons we have to trust the reliability of this account about Jesus' resurrection?
- Why are the women amazed, astonished and fearful?
- Why does the angel tell Mary to go tell Peter specifically that Jesus was alive? How does this encourage you regarding the forgiveness of God for our worst mistakes?
- What does Jesus' resurrection now mean for us and for our future? What does 1 Corinthians 15 teach us?
- How does the resurrection of Jesus give us hope for our future and how does that help us face trouble today?

For Group Leaders and Group Discussion

Use zoom to connect with group members. The first 40 meetings are free. There is a need to use this time wisely. So divide your time into three increments:

- Check in: ask each person to tell the group how they are doing and how the group can pray for them.
- Discuss sermon and reading: what has God been teaching you through His Word and the teaching from Sunday? How can you apply what you are reading? How are you sharing the love of Jesus with others or how can you share the love of Jesus with others this week?
- Read a passage of Scripture together and pray: Read Luke 6 together and especially focus on Jesus' teaching starting in verse 20. Remember to follow the pattern of what does the text say, what does it mean and how can I/we apply it?
