### Opening

How does this definition cause you to think about the reconciliation God offers us? What about when we think about some of the worst sins someone could commit? How is this good news?
- What does it mean to be an ambassador in general?
- [Read Philippians 3:20](#). What does it mean to be an ambassador or a news reporter with our citizenship in heaven?
- In Celebrate Recovery, they say, “Yield myself to God, to be used to bring the good news to others, both by my example and my words.” What does this mean to you?
