## **ICEBREAKER**

- 1. Do highs and lows from the last week!

## DIG A LITTLE DEEPER

- 1. Review the message
  - a. The foundation of our faith is the historical event of the resurrection of Jesus.
  - b. Christians who have already died are with Jesus, not in heaven.
  - c. Jesus will raise those who have died first and then take all believers with him at one time.
  - d. Our final destination post-death will be the new and restored earth.
- 2. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14
  - a. What do you think Paul means when he says not to grieve like the rest of mankind? How does "mankind" grieve?
  - b. How are Christians to grieve and simultaneously hold onto hope at the same time?
  - c. How does the historical event of Jesus' resurrection from death help us in grief?
  - d. What is Paul trying to say when he says some have "fallen asleep in him?"
- 3. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:15-18
  - a. When you think about Jesus coming back, the end times, does it give you fear or comfort? Why?
  - b. Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-58. What other new insights do we gain about what will happen upon Jesus' return?
  - c. What about Eric's message or these passages has challenged your pre-conceived ideas about what happens in the end times? Or did you find yourself in agreement?
  - d. How does knowing our eternal home is the new earth and not heaven sit with you? Is this a challenging or freeing idea?

## **CLOSING**

- 1. Who is someone in your life who needs this hope right now? How can you through either word or action proclaim this message of hope to them?
