Opening

- What is the worst time you've ever forgotten something important?
- What is the funniest thing you've ever forgotten and how did you make do without it?

Discussion

- What is the importance of becoming more specific in our church mission?
- Read Psalm 106:1-2. God's past faithfulness inspires us to believe that he will be faithful in the future. What is a time you saw the goodness, love, and faithfulness of the Lord?
- After 400 years, the Israelites doubted God would bring them into freedom. Has there ever been a time where you have waited years for an answer from the Lord?
- Read Psalm 106:9-12. God always pursues a relationship of trust with his people. What circumstances in your life have grown your trust?
- Eric said, "we are willing to obey someone to the degree that we trust them." Where are some places you have obeyed God only because you have trusted him?
- Read Psalm 106:13. Have you ever forgotten what God has done for you in the past?
- Have you ever been worried about your future in a way that tells you you've forgotten what God has done for you in the past?
- Read Psalm 106:14-15. God isn't out to get us, but there are natural consequences in the universe when we live outside of God's best for us. Have you ever experienced a consequence of not trusting God in your life?
- How does trusting God give us the freedom to give financially? How is that a great way to remember the faithfulness of God?
- How does living in community help us to remember the faithfulness of God?
- How does serving help us to remember the faithfulness of God?
- What is the cost of not remembering the faithfulness of God?

Application

- How can you pursue a relationship of trust with God this week?
- How can you make it a part of your daily routine to remember what God has done?
- What are some practical ways you can create a church that unchurched people love to engage?
