- God sees a church that is composed of people of various races. What might it look like for you to be like the men from Cyprus and Cyrene, talking to people different from you about the good news about Jesus?
- Why do you think it is important for the American church to intentionally lament over the racial division in our country?
- Read Romans 12:15. What would it look like for us to lament for our black brothers and sisters?

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• Is there a practical step that you might need to take as part of lamenting for the hurt and brokenness caused by the historical racism in our country?
