

5 CORE VALUES

LEADER GUIDE - SESSION 1 INTRO

Opening Prayer: Begin your time together by asking God to guide your discussion and help you understand and apply the core values of the church.

Key Takeaways:

1. Core values are things that are elevated, prioritized, and guide our behavior and decisions.
2. Mission is the destination (where we're headed), while core values are the compass (how we get there).
3. Core values help focus our energy and resources for greater impact.
4. True North Church has five core values that shape everything they do.

Discussion Questions:

1. What stood out to you most from the teaching about Core Values? Why?
2. The teaching mentioned the story of Mary and Martha (Luke 10). How does this story illustrate the importance of focusing on what truly matters?
3. Which of the five core values resonates most with you personally? Why?
4. Which core value do you feel you need to grow in the most? What makes you say that?
5. How do you think having clear core values as a church can impact our community and our effectiveness in introducing people to Jesus?
6. Ps. Josh mentioned four challenges: know, own, carry, and protect the core values. Which of these do you find most challenging? How can we help each other in these areas?

Follow-up and Closing Prayer: Encourage group members to pay attention to how they see these core values in action at church. Be prepared to share observations at the next Crew. Thank God for the clear direction He's given the church through these core values. Ask for His help in aligning your lives with these values and making a greater impact for His kingdom.
