4 Where am I going?

Caleb waited 45 years to take the land god promised him. You need to move to a place where you are effecting others.

Caleb was given the best land, he wasn't even an Israelite. God honored his faithfulness. God honors the heart, you can't hind you heart.

5 Will I finish strong?

King Hezekiah was a good King until the prophet came to him and told him he was going to die and it reveled something in his heart. Hezekiah pleaded with the prophet to give him more time. God gave him 15 more years but they were terrible years.

Isaiah 39:8 Reveals the heart of Hezekiah. He pleaded to the prophet to not allow judgement on him but to keep it for his child and grandchild.
