## 5 CORE VALUES LEADER GUIDE - SESSION 5 SAVED TO SERVE

**Opening Prayer**: Begin the session with a prayer, asking God to open hearts and minds to understand and apply the message of serving others.

## **Key Takeaways:**

- 1. Jesus exemplified servant leadership and calls us to do the same.
- 2. We are called to serve not just in church, but in all areas of our lives.
- 3. Serving others brings blessings and refreshment to our own lives.
- 4. Ultimately, we serve God through serving others.
- 5. Everyone has unique gifts and talents to contribute in service.

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. How does Jesus' example of servant leadership challenge your perspective on leadership and service?
- 2. The sermon mentions "knowing, owning, carrying, and protecting" the core values. How can we specifically apply this to the value of "Saved to Serve"?
- 3. Reflect on a time when serving others brought unexpected blessings or refreshment to your own life. Share with the group.
- 4. The speaker emphasizes that we ultimately serve God, not just people. How does this perspective change your approach to serving?
- 5. What unique gifts, talents, or experiences do you have that you could use to serve others? How might God use these to bless His people and further His mission?
- 6. What obstacles or hesitations do you face when it comes to serving? How can we overcome these as individuals and as a group?

**Follow-up and Closing Prayer:** Take a moment to reflect and share with the group: Encourage group members to take a concrete step towards serving this week. This could be signing up for a church team, organizing a service project, or finding a way to serve in their workplace or community. End the session by praying for opportunities to serve, and for a heart that reflects Christ's servant leadership.
