LEADER GUIDE - SESSION 2 UNTIL EVERYONE KNOWS

Opening Prayer: Ask God to open hearts and minds to discuss His call for evangelism and its impact through our lives and as a community of believers.

Key Takeaways:

1. Evangelism is about sharing the gospel, not saving people - that's God's role.
2. All Christians are called to be "fishers of men" and share the good news.
3. The gospel is centered on Jesus Christ, not our good works.
4. There's a spiritual hunger in today's world, creating opportunities for evangelism.

Discussion Questions:

1. What comes to mind when you hear the word "evangelism"? Share any positive or negative associations.
2. Ps. Brian mentioned that evangelism shouldn't be a crushing weight. Have you ever felt burdened by evangelism? How can we maintain a healthy perspective?
3. Read Mark 16:15. What does it mean to "go into every aspect of society" with the gospel? How can we apply this in our daily lives?
4. What obstacles prevent you from sharing Christ with others? How can we overcome these barriers?
5. Share a time when you had the opportunity to share your faith. What was the experience like?

Follow-up and Closing Prayer: Encourage group members to express how they see this core value in action at church. Identify one person in your life who doesn't know Jesus. Commit to praying for them daily and looking for opportunities to share the gospel. Thank God for the gift of salvation and ask for courage and opportunities to share the gospel this week.
