The importance of the church environment

We should operate in the sense of transparency and vulnerability.

We are supposed to be DEAD to ourselves!! But Christ lives in us!

We gave up the right to our fleshly desires when we said yes to Jesus!

We welcome transparency but take sin seriously. Sin separates us from God!
