WEEK FOUR

Sunday- Reflect

Spend a few moments reflecting on today's message.

- What stood out to you?
- What challenged or encouraged you?
- What's one thing you heard today that you want to carry into this week?

Pray: Spend a few minutes talking with Jesus about today's message. Ask Him to continue speaking to you as you spend intentional time with Him this week.

Monday- Read

Proverbs 16:1-3;9

- What do these verses say about our plans and God's direction?
- What stands out the most to you?
- What's the difference between making plans and trying to control the future?
- What does it mean to "commit your plans to the Lord"?

Pray: Talk with Jesus about the plans and dreams you have for your life. Ask Him to help you hold them with open hands

Tuesday- Examine

James 4:13-15

- What are you currently working towards?
- What are you hoping will happen?
- Is there something you feel like has to happen for your life to turn out right?
- How do you respond when your plans don't work out?
- Is there a dream that has become more important to you than trusting Jesus?

Pray: Tell Jesus honestly what you want for your future. Ask Him to reveal where a good desire may have become something you're unwilling to surrender.

WEEK FOUR

Wednesday- Pray

Pray Slowly through **Psalm 37:4-5**

Delight yourself in the Lord.....Pause and Pray

He will give you the desires of your heart.....Pause and Pray

Commit your way to the Lord.....Pause and Pray

Trust in Him and He will act.....Pause and Pray

Thursday- Respond

Colossians 3:17

- Is there a dream that God has placed in front of you?
- Is there a step that you've been too afraid to take?
- Is there something you've been waiting to feel completely ready for?
- Is there something you need to stop chasing?
- What can you faithfully do today while trusting God with tomorrow?

Pray: Ask Jesus for wisdom to know when to move, when to wait, and when to let go.

Friday- Remember

Isaiah 55:8-9

- When has life gone differently than you planned?
- Can you see anywhere God worked through an unexpected change?
- Is there a closed door you're now thankful didn't open?
- Is there a disappointment you still don't understand?
- Where have you seen God's faithfulness even when you couldn't see His plan?

Pray: Thank Jesus for the ways you've seen His faithfulness. Bring Him the parts of your story you still don't understand.

Saturday- Prepare

Pray: Ask God to prepare your heart for worship tomorrow. Ask Him to remove any distractions that may hinder you from hearing His voice.
