- love? Why is both important? Why does this take strength?
- 19 | What is the purpose of this all?
 20-21 | Why is this an important way to end the prayer?

Key Verse

Ephesians 3.16 | that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in your inner being ...

Application

- This is Paul's prayer for the Ephesians. Is this what your prayers for other people look like? How do most of today's prayers differ from the way Paul prays for these people?
- Is it wrong to pray for things like comfort, health, safety and jobs?
- If God answered all of your prayers, how many eternities would be different and how much LIFE would be added to the people around you?
- Why is it important to pray for
 others like Paul prays for others?
- Do your prayers require you to end your prayers like Paul does in verse 20? If not, they may be too small.
