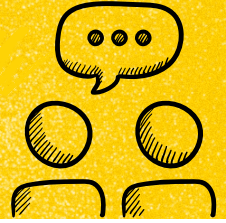

Key Verse

James 3.17 | But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere.

Application Questions

- Who is the wisest person that you know?
 - Why did you choose them?

- Where in your life does jealousy easily creep in?
- Who is someone in your life that you can receive wise council from?

Life Questions

- Anything we can pray for this week?
- Anyone hurting around you that we can pray for or love this week?

Diving In Questions

- How would you define wisdom?
- What is the proof of wisdom?
- Jealousy and selfish ambition are both mentioned twice in the six verses on wisdom - why do you think that is?
- What is the difference between true wisdom that comes from above and earthly wisdom?
- Why do you think James says, "in the meekness of wisdom"?
- Out of the "fruits" of wisdom from above, which ones stick out to you the most? Are any of them surprising?
