Advancing the Gospel

<u>Big Idea</u>: God designs the events of our lives to advance the gospel.

The gospel was advancing because...

- 1. Paul knew his imprisonment was for Christ. 1:12,13
 - a. He accepted life's situations as God-ordained opportunities to advance the gospel. (12)
 - b. He used it to make Christ known to everyone (13)

2 Tim. 2:8,9 – the word of God is NOT bound!

- 2. Paul's imprisonment for Christ emboldened other believers. 1:14
 - a. It gave them confidence in the Lord. 1 Thess. 2:2
 - b. It brought **boldness** to speak the word. Eph. 6:19,20
 - c. It removed <u>fear</u>. Heb. 13:5,6
- 3. Paul's imprisonment resulted in Christ being proclaimed, bringing him joy, regardless of the motives! 1:15-18
 - a. Some preached Christ with <u>selfish</u> motives.
 - b. Most preached Christ sincerely.

<u>Bottom Line:</u> Paul, and most of the brethren, were bold, knowing that his imprisonment was ordained by God for the defense of the gospel.

2 Questions to Consider:

- Have I accepted my life's situations as God-ordained opportunities to advance the gospel?
- How can I prepare myself to defend the gospel this week?
