The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse (The opening of the first four seals) Revelation 6:1-8 December 6, 2020

...for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury. - Romans 2:8

The First Seal - The White Horse that brings a bloodless conquering. - vv. 1–2

1. The first horse is white symbolizing a form of righteousness. v. 2

- Matthew 24:23-24

2. This rider had a bow without arrows. v. 2

3. The rider was given a crown. v. 2

4. The rider came to conquer. v. 2

The Second Seal - the Red Horse that brings war. vv. 3-4

- Matthew 24:6-7a

1. The horse's fiery red color symbolizes war. v. 4

2. The rider removes any existence of peace from the earth. v. 4a

3. This rider brings about a savage nature among people. v. 4b

4. This rider was given a great sword. v. 4

Jeremiah 25:15-17, 27-28; Revelation 3:10; 1 Thessalonians 5:9-11

The Third Seal: the Black Horse that brings famine. vv. 5-6

1. The horse's color is black, suggesting a time of lamentation and mourning. v. 5a

2. The rider is holding scales symbolizing the scarcity of provisions. v. 5b

3. John hears a special announcement. v. 6

a. ...a quart of wheat for a denarius...

b. ...and three quarts of barley for a denarius...

c. ...do not harm the oil and wine...

The Fourth Seal: the Pale Horse that bring immense death. vv. 7-8

1. The horse's pale color symbolizes death and decay. v. 8

- 2. This horse has a rider and one following on foot. v. 8
- 3. This rider and his companion kill on an unprecedented scale. v. 8
- 4. Death will come from many sources. v. 8
