8 points of introduction —

1. This book is a revealing. - ***The revelation...*** - Revelation 1:1

2. This book is a revealing of Jesus Christ. - ***The revelation of Jesus Christ...*** - Revelation 1:1

3. This book is a revealing by God and is given to his Son. - ...***which God gave him...*** - Revelation 1:1

4. This book came from God to Jesus who then gives it to His followers. - ...***to show to his servants...*** - Revelation 1:1

5. This book reveals things that will happen soon. v. 1 - ...***that must soon take place.*** - Revelation 1:1

6. This book came to John supernaturally. v. 1 - ***He made it known by sending his angel...*** - Revelation 1:1

7. This book brings the promise of blessing. v. 3 - ***Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear ...*** - Revelation 1:3

8. This book encourages a sense of urgency. v. 3 - ...***for the time is near.*** - Revelation 1:3
