- 1. There are four angels who control the forces of nature. v. 1
- a. These angels are stationed at the outskirts of the earth. v. 1
- b. The angels are restraining the winds. v. 1
- c. The four winds are best seen as the coming trumpet judgments.
- 2. A fifth angel enters the scene carrying a seal. v. 2
- a. The phrase *rising of the sun* was another way of saying the east. v. 2a
- b. This seal was unique from the other seals. v. 2.
- 3. The fifth angel gives instructions to the other four. vv. 2-3
- 4. The fifth angel ensures the protection of God's servants on earth. v. 3
- a. The seal has the name of the Lamb and the Father.
- Revelation 14:1
- b. The seal provides a <u>protection</u> from the judgments.
- Ezekiel 9:4-5
- Revelation 9:3-4
- c. The promised security does not shield these servants from martyrdom.
- Revelation 13:15
- d. Any suffering or persecution toward these saints come from God's enemies, not God himself.
- 5. The sealed are protected in order to serve God. vv. 3-4
- a. The sealed are best seen as slaves. v. 3
- b. The number of those who receive the seal is 144,000. v. 4
- c. These 144,000 are part of ethnic <u>Israel</u>. vv. 5-8
