Reasons to study Philippians

- 1. Philippians teaches us what it means to live joyful in unstable times.
- 2. Philippians teaches us how to live with our focus on God and heaven.
- 3. Philippians teaches us how to have <u>peace</u> when our circumstances seem bleak.

Background

- 1. Philippians is a <u>thank you</u> letter.
- 2. This is a <u>doctrinally</u> deep letter.

Philippians 1:1-2

- 1. Christians are considered slaves to Christ. v. 1a
- Romans 6:17a, 18
- I Corinthians 6:19-20a
- 2. Christians are also considered saints in Christ. v. 1
- 3. Christians are the constant beneficiaries of God's grace. v. 2a
- a. The word grace is to remind the Christian of God's unmerited favor toward them. v. 2a
- Romans 5:8
- b. The word grace is to remind the Christian of God's unceasing forgiveness. v. 2a
- Romans 5:20
- 4. Christians are the constant beneficiaries of God's peace. v. 2
- a. Before we came to Jesus we were not in a peaceful relationship with God.
- b. Grace gives us a peaceful relationship with God.
