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This Week We Learned About ...

...the Armor of God, a great example of how to protect themselves from hurt, pain, regret, temptation and hardship. This lesson makes God's divine protection very easy to understand as a coat of armor for daily living!

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✓ Questions for Kids:

1. We should wear the breastplate of what?
A. Righteousness
2. And carry the shield of what? **A. Faith**
3. And the helmet of? **A. Salvation**

✓ Dinner Table Discussion:

A breastplate protects our heart. How can being righteous keep our hearts safe from evil? Discuss it with your family.

A shield is something we hold up when someone throws or shoots a weapon at us. What are some of the spiritual weapons people use? For example: someone might laugh at Christianity to makes us doubt, or peer pressure us into behaving badly. Can you think of more? How does having faith shield us from such weapons?
