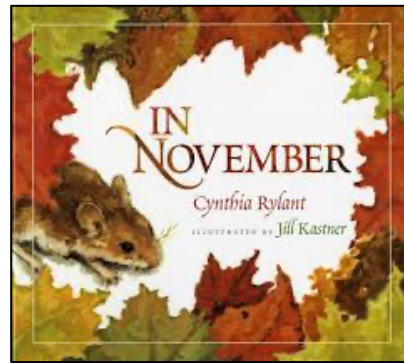

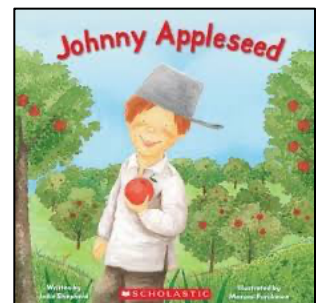
- Introduced Nn.
