

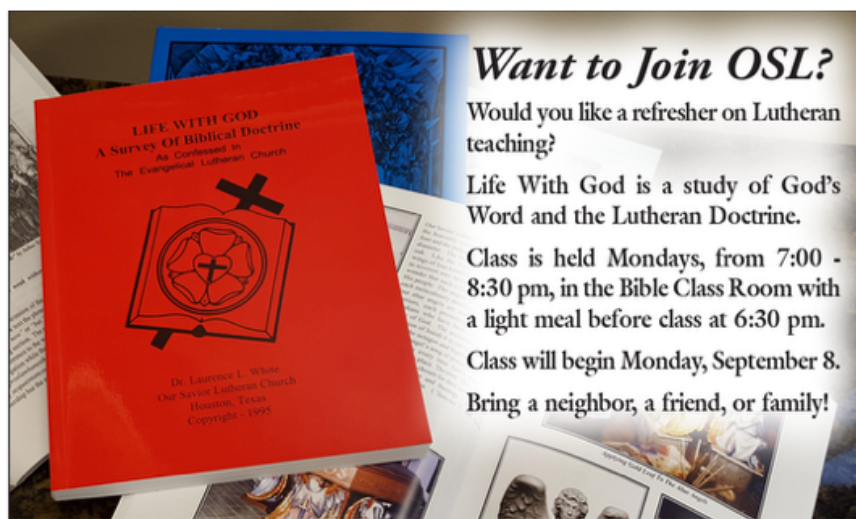

Science focus this week

The Periodic Table of Elements are organized by the number of electrons on the outermost part of the atom by columns. It is also organized by the number of orbitals for the electrons. Recent discoveries now refute the idea that electrons circulate around the nucleus like planets. The quantum-mechanical model describes electrons as moving around in regions called orbitals and looks like the model on the right.
