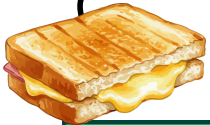

What we're learning...
(Same as last week)

- ~ The Perfect System passive voice tenses are formed using the 4th principal part, also called a participle or verbal adjective, and a form of the verb sum
- ~ The pluperfect tense passive voice uses the imperfect tense forms of sum
- ~ The 4th principal part of the verb is a regular 1st/2nd declension adjective with endings for all three genders
- ~ The perfect passive participle must match the subject in number and gender; the sum form must match the subject in person and number

What we're learning...

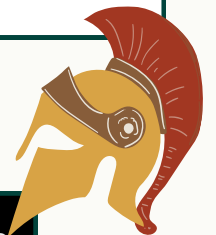
- ~ We are still working with prepositions, but in this lesson, these prepositions take, or govern, the accusative case.
- ~ Generally, prepositions which express "motion toward" take the accusative case, while prepositions that express "location, no motion, or motion from" take the ablative case
- ~ Two prepositions, in & sub, can take either case and translate slightly different with each case.

What we're learning...

- ~ All verb endings include a pronoun ~ the ending expresses what "person" is doing the action.
- ~ Even though a pronoun is included in the verb ending, it can also be expressed separately
- ~ In this lesson, we are learning the 1st person personal pronouns; 1st person personal pronouns have forms for number and case, but not gender
