Thank you to all the parents who chaperoned our field trip, and to those who volunteered to help with the Valentine's party. Your help and support mean so much to our class and our success!

This week your scholars added multiple four-digit numbers, using sums of 10. Next week, they will show their knowledge by completing the unit test in math. Additional practice was sent home with them over the weekend to keep them sharp and prepare them to master their test!

In English we are continuing with classifying sentences, adding conjunctions and compound parts. The scholars learned how to tell a simple sentence from a sentence fragment and add a subject or predicate to a fragment to turn it into a sentence. They also began joining two sentences together to form a compound sentence. In literature, we began reading *The Courage of Sarah Noble* by Alice Dalgliesh and have been discussing what it is to be brave in the face of danger and uncertainty.

In religion, we have been learning to books of the Bible (ask them to sing you their song) and about the public ministry of Jesus. The scholars learned about Aristotle's ideas on animal classification in science, and in history we learned about the rise of Athens and Sparta and compared each Greek city state.

Friday, Memorial Lutheran advanced band came to OSL to preform several wonderful pieces of music for us, It was such a treat, and the scholars loved listening to them play.

Your scholars are working hard and making big leaps in their education. I am proud of them all!
