



Logic I Ch. 13 Qualitative Rules Quiz Monday 11/10

There are Seven Rules for determining validity in a Syllogism. They are divided into Three categories:

Terminological Rules

- 1. There must be Three and Only Three Terms.
- 2. The Middle Term must not occur in the Conclusion.

Quantitative Rules

- 3. If a Term is Distributed in the Conclusion, then it must be Distributed in the Premise.
- 4. The Middle Term must be distributed at least once.

Qualitative Rules

- 5. No Conclusion can follow from two Negative Premises.
- 6. If the two Premises are affirmative, the Conclusion must also be affirmative.
- 7. If either Premise is Negative, the Conclusion must also be Negative.

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Logic II

Ch. 12 Epicheimera Quiz Tuesday 11/11

An **Epicheimera** is an argument in which at least one of the premises contains causal propositions. A **causal proposition** includes proof for the proposition or the reason for believing the proposition to be true.

First Order Epicheirema- The causal proposition is in the major premise.

All M is P, <u>since r</u> All S is M Therefore, S is P

Second Order Epicheirema- The causal proposition is in the minor premise.

All M is P All S is M, <u>since r</u> Therefore, S is P

Third Order Epicheirema- The causal propositions are in both the major and minor premises.

All M is P, <u>since r</u> All S is M, <u>since r</u> Therefore, S is P
