LITERATURE/POETRY: "Where the Wild Things Are" by Maurice Sandak

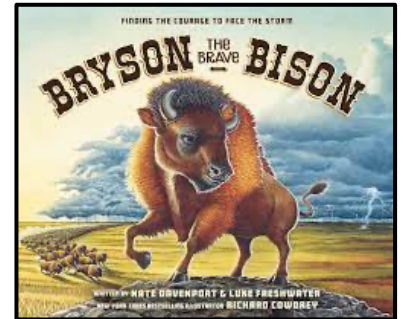
ART/ACTIVITY: polar bears
