This week we have been reading *Little House in the Big Woods* by Laura Ingalls Wilder and discussing the day-to-day life of early pioneers. The scholars thought about all the chores they would have to do if they were children back in Laura's time, and how things would be different for them. As a class, we learned how to make butter and then made some of our own! We tasted it on yummy homemade sourdough bread. We also talked about how nothing was wasted, and a few brave scholars tasted buttermilk. In science we started an experiment on how wounds heal using alcohol and ground beef. We will check the results of our experiment on Monday! Adding 3-digit numbers has been challenging for the scholars, so I decided to spend a few more days on Unit 11. We will test mid-week. We will be conducting our classroom spelling bee next week. Have scholars brush up on their spelling skills by reviewing the list of words that was sent home 2 weeks ago!
