What a week we had! We got to see the 7th and 8th grade logic school scholars re-enact Romeo and Juliet and A Midsummer Night's Dream, as well as the OSL teachers' Reformation play. This week we also skip counted by 5s, learned how to identify prepositions, object of the preposition, and the prepositional phrase. We will be learning how to select a topic and write a supporting sentence in preparation for writing an explanatory paragraph. In religion we have been learning about God appointing judges to rule over his people, and in literature we completed Prairie School by Avi. I will be collecting their Prairie School books on Monday.
