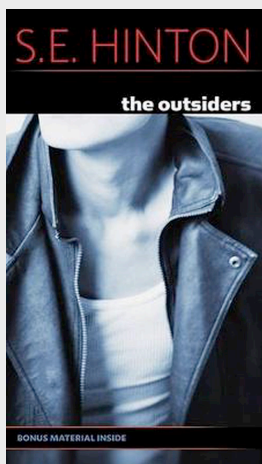

S.E.Hinton.

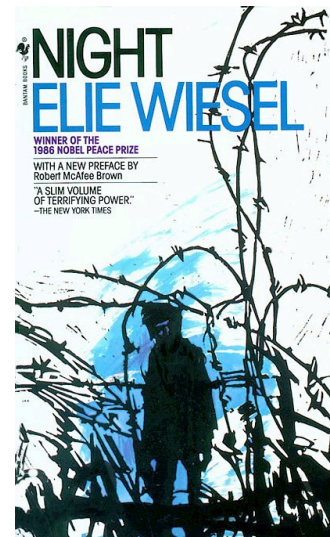

Night by Elie Wiesel

Elizer, his father, and the other prisoners are evacuated from Buna ahead of the Soviet advance. They are march relentlessly through a blizzard to transportation to their next camp. Many prisoners die on the march, and many more die in the open train cattle cars packed with 100 prisoners each. By the time they arrive at Buchenwald, only 12 men are alive.



Elizer's father is so weak with dysentery that he is bedridden. Elizer is advised by another prisoner to forget about his father and save himself, a thought Elizer cannot comprehend. Elizer wakes after a difficult night to someone else in his father's bed.

When the American army arrives to liberate Buchenwald, the prisoners only think about food. When Elizer looks in a mirror, he is shocked: "From the depths of the mirror," Wiesel writes, "a corpse gazed back at me."
