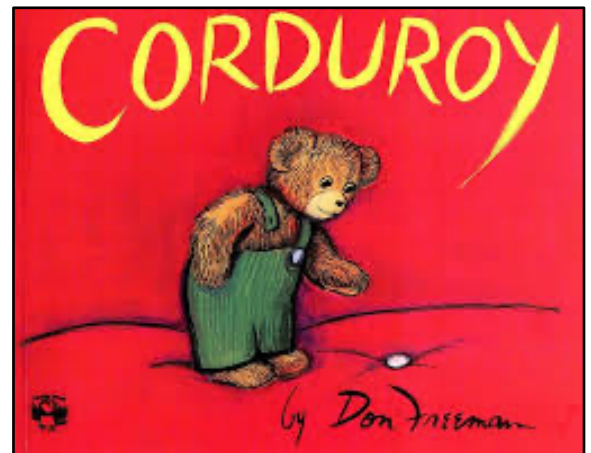

LETTERS & NUMBERS

- Ff – Letter box and song book. Tracing on dry erase pockets. Sky-writing.
- Reviewed 2 – Song book. Discuss things related to two: things that come in pairs – socks, gloves, ice skates; twins; peanut butter and jelly, macaroni and cheese, salt and pepper, etc.

OUTDOOR LEARNING (Tuesday afternoon)

- Senses Hunt: **SIGHT** (Can you see clouds? Can you see birds?), **SOUND** (Can you hear a bird? Can you hear cars drive by?), **TOUCH** (Can you touch rough tree bark? Can you touch a smooth rock?), **TASTE** (What is something outside that you could eat?), **SMELL** (Can you smell flowers? Can you smell rain? Can you smell dirt?) See *attached handout for children to use with a clipboard and check off when they have found an item for each of their five senses.*

SCIENCE (Thursday)

- **SIGHT** (Look at optical illusions.), **SOUND** (Listen to “What was that Sound?” game on YouTube.), **TOUCH** (Touch boxes, blindfolded.), **TASTE** (bitter, dark chocolate; salty, pretzel; sour, lemon; sweet, marshmallows), **SMELL** (Blind-folded sniff test: lavender, cinnamon, peppermint.)
