# Getting Started with New Routines

With the help of their teachers and aides, the children seem to be adjusting well to their new classes and to the routines of the classroom. There are so many things to learn and remember as you and your child begin the school year. Here are some helpful reminders:

### **Morning Drop-off**

When dropping off, arrive on time as some children feel insecure when arriving late and the class has already begun. We recommend a short goodbye in the mornings at drop-off as lingering goodbyes are not helpful for most children. Some children may take some time to adjust, and it is much easier for the staff to encourage this adjustment after you are gone. Remember, you may use the drop-off carline or you may park behind the portable buildings, and walk your child to the classroom in the morning—this is your choice as a parent.


### Please do not cross the car line on foot!

### **Be On Time**

Please be on time as our teachers like to start their day with their scholars at 8:00 am sharp. Our lobby opens at 7:35 am, with Mrs. Calloway monitoring the children until teachers open their classroom doors at 7:40 am. Please bring your child a little before 8:00 am to give them a chance to unpack, play, and visit with friends before the school day officially begins. We appreciate your efforts with this.

### Dismissal

Please use the **Pikmykid app** to announce your arrival on campus, and display your child's name sign in your car window. We will walk your child to the car.





### **Folders**

Remember to send back your child's folder *empty* at the beginning of each new week. Take time to look at your child's work; they will be proud to show you!

### **Emails**

Please stay current with the all school email newsletter that is sent every Thursday. Each homeroom teacher also sends an email out every week highlighting news from the classroom. You can also find the teacher's newsletter on the OSL app.

Set an alarm to order lunch for your child each Sunday for the following week. Lunch orders for each day cut off at 6:00 am.


# God Is Love

# Pick Up Procedures @ ECE Porch

Parents must pick up their children at the Early Childhood Center's porch:

- Please park, and walk to the ECE porch.
  - Please do not use the car line. The car line is for parents picking up their child from Extended Care.
- Children who remain on campus after their activity ends will be cared for in Extended Care—pickup at the ECE porch.

### **Parent Spectators**

Parents are welcome to watch their children participate in soccer, gymnastics, and tae kwon do. All other activities are for participants only.

Coaches will dismiss participants to parents who have watched their child in soccer, gymnastics or tae kwon do.

# Not Attending an Activity One Afternoon?

If your child will not attend their after school activity as usual one afternoon, please let your child's teacher know.

# Picking Up Early from an After School Activity?

It is not recommended to pick up your child early from an after school activity. If necessary, please let your child's activity vendor know in advance that you plan to pick up your child early from the activity. Note that picking up early often takes a long time as most vendors do not have extra staff to escort the child. Additionally, OSL's Extended Care staff is not always readily available to assist with an early pickup.


