This week we began adding multiple three-digit numbers while using sums of tens to make adding large sums quicker. This is a hard concept, and we will be spending another week on it to ensure that the scholars have a solid understanding and mastery. We learned conjunctions and compound parts of sentences in English, concluded Little House in the Big Woods, studied the childhood of Jesus in religion, and continued our study of Aristotle's observations of the world around him by experimenting with rocks and gravity.
