## DAILY CLASSROOM SCHEDULE

Please see the attached paper for our daily schedule. It is important to be on time for school, as we leave for Morning Matins promptly at 8am and have Chapel on Wednesdays at 8:15. The school day is over at 3:15pm. If your child is not picked up by 3:30pm, they will be checked into extended care.

## CHAPEL

We have chapel on Wednesdays at 8:15 am in the church. Because it is so early it will be important to have your child at the school by 8am. Please feel free to join us for chapel at the church, can have your child sit with you. Also, if you would like to send offering money, an offering "baggie" will be sent home every week in their Friday folder.

## SHOW & TELL STUDENT FOLDERS

Show & Tell will be on Thursdays. We will have a specific theme. For example: If the letter of the week is "E", they will need to bring in something that begins with the letter "E" and the short /E/ sound. During review weeks, your child can bring in an item of their choice. I will let you know the "theme" in my weekly newsletter. Please do not bring in living things, anything valuable or large, bulky items.

They will come home on Thursdays. Please empty them & return on Monday. Other items may come home during the week, so it is always a good idea to look in your child's backpack every day.

## NAPMATS

Your child's cloth nap mat will come home on their last day of the week. Please wash it and return it on Monday/Tuesday.

They will not need a plastic nap mat this year.

## LUNCH & SNACK

Lunch and snack are both eaten in my classroom. I do ask that you send a **morning snack** and **afternoon snack** in a *separate pocket* or bag in their backpack.

## BIRTHDAYS

Birthdays are exciting & we will recognize your child's special day at school. If you would like to bring a treat to share with the class, you may bring small individual-serve goodies, such as mini-cupcakes or small cookies. We will have them with our lunch. Also, if you would like to share a special lunch with the class - it must come from a restaurant & be individually packaged (kids' meals - not platters.) If your child has a summer birthday, we will celebrate their half-birthday, or you can just pick a date - just let me know.
