I am sending the list of lock words that we have covered so far. You will notice the words that your child doesn't know are crossed out. Here are some fun ways to practice the words that they didn't know:

1. Play tic tac toe with the words in the spaces. You must read the word to put an x or o.
2. Make flash cards. Put a picture or star on the back of one of the cards. The scholar reads the word and looks on the back to see if they found the star. You can pick a number to see if they can find the star in ___tries.
3. Put the cards on the ground. Scholar rolls the dice and moves that many spaces(the child is the moving piece) while reading the words. If they miss a word, they go back to the beginning.
4. You can always post the cards on the refrigerator.
5. Have your child read the cards one at a time. Every card they read correctly, they keep. Every word they get wrong, you keep. Whoever has the most cards wins.

6. Put the words upside down on the floor. Freeze dance. When the music stops pick up the word and read it. If they get it correct, they keep it. If they get it wrong, you keep it or put it back down on the floor.
7. Write the words outside with water and a paint brush or an ice cube.
